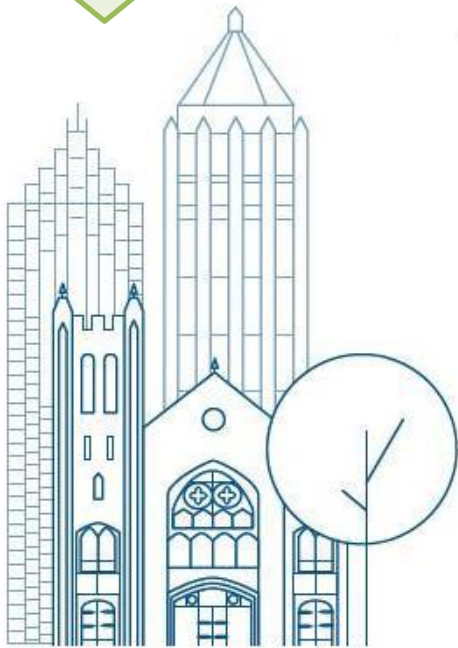

Midtown Assistance Center was formed in 1986 by the Midtown Alliance and midtown congregations. MAC's mission is to provide emergency assistance to low-income families to prevent homelessness and hunger during periods of crisis.



This year, MAC has helped 3,782 people with rent and utility payments, groceries, transportation passes, clothing and work shoes, and Georgia identification.
